This book addresses the behavior of inorganic material in combustion systems. The past decade has seen unprecedented improvements in understanding the rates and mechanisms of inorganic transformations and in developing analytical tools to predict them. These tools range from improved fuel analysis procedures to predictive computer codes. While this progress has been met with great enthusiasm within the research community, the practices of the industrial community remain largely unchanged. The papers in this book were selected from those presented at an Engineering Foundation Conference of the same title. All have been peer reviewed. The intent of the conference was to illustrate the application of advanced technology to ash-related problems in boilers and, by so doing, engage the research and industrial communities in more productive dialog. Those attending the conference generally felt that we were successful on these counts. We also engaged the industrial community to a greater extent than ever before in the conference discussion and presentation. We hope these proceedings will facilitate a continued and improved interaction between industrial and research communities. Behavior of inorganic material has long been recognized as one of the major considerations affecting the design and operation of boilers that burn ash-producing fuels. The practical problems associated with the behavior are sometimes catastrophic and spectacular, ranging from major slag falls that damage the bottom of furnaces to complete plugging of convection passes. Die 10. Vollversammlung befasste sich außer mit der notvollen Lage der gespaltenen koreanischen Halbinsel hauptsächlich mit den Themen Mission, Einheit, Gerechtigkeit und Frieden. Die ökumenische Bewegung ist dank der Anwesenheit und offiziellen Stellungnahmen von Vertretern der Weltweiten Evangelischen Allianz, der Pfingstkirchen, der Lausanner Bewegung u. a. in Busan erweitert und gestärkt worden. Die über 800 Delegierten der 345 Mitgliedskirchen haben das Programm des ÖRK für die nächsten sieben Jahre diskutiert und unter der Überschrift verabschiedet: 'Pilgerweg der Gerechtigkeit und des Friedens'. In diesem offiziellen Dokumentationsband sind alle wichtigen Beiträge enthalten, dazu die Berichte von Generalsekretär Olav Fykse Tveit und dem Vorsitzenden des Zentralausschusses Walter Altmann. Wer über die gegenwärtige ökumenische Lage Bescheid wissen und mitreden will, braucht dieses Buch in seiner Handbibliothek. Der Band ist ein Sammelwerk, der zwölf Beiträge umfasst, die aus einer gleichnamigen Tagung an der Johann Wolfgang Goethe-Universität Frankfurt im Fach Südostasienwissenschaften hervorgegangen sind und um einige weitere Beiträge ergänzt wurden. Alle Beiträge befassen sich mit dem teils recht schwierigen Verhältnis zwischen Muslimen und ihren nicht-muslimischen Mitbürgern. Da der Band Beiträge umfasst, die dieses Verhältnis sowohl in dominant muslimischen wie auch dominant nicht-muslimischen Gesellschaften thematisiert, werden unterschiedliche Aspekte dargeboten, die breite Vergleichsmöglichkeiten eröffnen. The Promise of Reconciliation? explores the relationship between violence, nonviolence, and reconciliation in societal conflicts with questions such as: In what ways does violence impact the reconciliation process that necessarily follows a cessation of deadly conflict? Would an understanding of how conflict has been engaged, with violence or nonviolence, be conducive to how it could be prevented from sliding further into violence?The contributors examine international influences on the peace/reconciliation process in Indonesia's Aceh conflict, as well as the role of Muslim religious scholars in promoting peace. They also examine the effect of violence in southern Thailand, where insurgent violence has provided "leverage" during the fighting, but negatively affects post-conflict objectives. The chapter on Sri Lanka shows that "successful" violence does not necessarily end conflict?Sri Lankan society today is more polarized than it was before its civil war. The Vietnam chapter argues that the rise of nonviolent protest in Vietnam reflects a profound loss of state legitimacy, which cannot be resolved with force, while another chapter on Thailand examines "Red Sunday," a Thai political movement engaged in nonviolent protest in the face of violent government suppression. The book ends with a look at Indonesian cities, sites of ethnic conflicts, as potential abodes of peace if violence can be curtailed. This textbook provides details of the derivation of Lagrange's planetary equations and of the closely related Gauss's variational equations, thereby covering a sorely needed topic in existing literature. Analytical solutions can help verify the results of numerical work, giving one confidence that his or her analysis is correct. The authors--all experienced experts in astrodynamics and space missions--take on the massive derivation problem step by step in order to help readers identify and understand possible analytical solutions in their own endeavors. It questions the meaning of democratization for women and their relationship to national sovereignty within the new Indonesian state, and discusses women's organizations and their activities; women's social and economic roles; and the different cultural, regional and ethnic attitudes towards women, while showing the failure of political change to fully address women's gender interests and needs. The author argues that both the role of nationalism in defining gender identity and the role of gender in defining national identity need equal recognition.
